Submission of the Full Text Paper

The completed article/paper should be received by **December 25, 2019** (Wednesday).

Please include a cover page (1st Page) containing the paper title, authors (indicate the primary contact person), address, affiliation, e-mail address, phone number, fax number and topic area of your paper. The 2nd page begins with paper title, abstract, keywords, and full text of the article/paper including tables, diagrams and figures.

Submissions, and all correspondence will be conducted by e-mail. Send your full article/paper via e-mail as an attachment document (not part of your e-mail).

Submission Guidelines

- 1. Papers should be typed on Microsoft Word-version, A4 paper size, with one (1) inch margin on all side, double-spaced, using Arial font size 12.
- 2. Use Times New Roman font size 8 for Headers and Footers.
- 3. Size of the complete paper must not exceed 10-15 pages, including tables and figures, but excluding references.

PowerPoint Presentation

The speaker/author is also required to prepare a brief presentation (15-20 minutes) on the gist of the theme/topic using PowerPoint.
